The **Sunapee Ragged Kearsarge Greenway Coalition** is a non-profit organization, run by volunteers from the towns traversed by the SRKG Trail. It was formed to develop a network of Hiking trails circling Lake Sunapee and including the peaks of Mount Sunapee, Ragged Mountain, and Mount Kearsarge.

Serial numbered certificates are awarded to all persons completing the full circuit of the SRK Greenway. Because the Greenway hike is about 75 miles in length (varying as the trail is developed and revised) it is likely that many may require months or years to complete the hike.

This Record Book is provided so that hikers may record the completion of trail segments, as they are completed. The honor system is utilized; as a segment or sub segments is completed, record the date and initial the entry.
