Trail Maintenance

Ten volunteers participated in a Trail Skills Workshop on the SRK Greenway in Newbury on October 24th. They studied principles and techniques of controlling water on hiking trails. Lew Shelley, trail designer and instructor of Snowhawk LLC, led the SRKGC-sponsored trail workshop which was supported by a grant from the Quabbin-to-Cardigan Partnership.

The project was funded by the Quabbin-to-Cardigan Partnership and SRK Greenway Coalition.
